
## TRAVEL TO ALÈS (1/2)

### Transportation

Alès is located in the South of France, between the Cévennes and the Mediterranean sea, 45km from Nîmes, 90km from Montpellier and 165km from Marseille. As the capital of the Cévennes, Alès is the sub-prefecture of the Gard and has a population of around 40,000 inhabitants.

### Coming to Alès

- The nearest airports are Nîmes airport (48km), Montpellier airport (61km) and Marseille airport (141km)
- It takes 3h to come from Paris to Nîmes by high-speed train. Then, there is a direct train line from Nîmes to Alès (35 minutes)
- To reach Alès by car/taxi, it takes 40 minutes from Nîmes airport, 1h from Montpellier airport and 1h30 from Marseille airport



### Coming to IMT Mines Alès

The IMT Mines Alès campuses are located in the city of Alès. The campus is divided into 2 sites :

- The **Clavières site** - Administration and teaching services, located at 6 avenue de clavières, 30319 Alès Cedex
- The **Croupillac site** - Louis Leprince-Ringuet technological campus with all the research centers edicated to materials (C2MA), environment (CREER) and IT&AI (CERIS), located at 1A rue Jules Renard, 30100 Alès

## TRAVEL TO ALÈS (2/2)

### Coming by bus from Alès train station

- Line 2 (L2): Gare-Clavières-Croupillac
- Line 3 (L3): Gare-Clavières-Croupillac
- Line 20 (L20): Gare-Clavières-Croupillac

Here are the bus stops corresponding to the different sites:

- SNCF station: «bus station» stop (L2, L3, L20)
- Clavières site: «Chantilly» stop (L2, L3, L20)
- Louis Leprince-Ringuet site (Croupillac): «Jules Renard» stop (L20), «Marot» stop (L2, L3)

### ACCESS

IMT Mines Alès has a **card-access control system**. You must go to reception and present an **identity document** ([passeport for non EU members](#)) to access the sites.
